Class Description:

Digital Media, 0.5 credit earned (F - 05)

Class Description:

In this class, students will learn how to use graphics and photo-editing software to create high-quality images that can be used in various publications. They will learn how to manipulate artwork using typographic design and vector drawing to create works that advertise events. Additionally, students will learn how to add and edit audio and video and work with cameras in raw and 3D environments. If time permits, students will also learn how to create web pages to present and reflect on their work by the end of the summer class. Upon completion of the class, students can earn 0.5 credits.

Geometry, 0.5 credit earned (F - 06)

Class Description:

This course is being offered to students who have shown a high aptitude in math and have demonstrated good study habits, indicating they will be able to move the course content quickly. It is being offered with the expectation that these students will continue to take higher-level math courses each year of high school. Students will be invited based on high grades in Algebra 1 (A to A+) and teacher recommendation. Students will earn .5 credit (half-year) for successful completion of this course with a C grade or higher. The course will involve using deductive proofs with geometric figures, surface area and volume of various solid shapes, basic trigonometry, coordinate geometry, and transformations of figures in the coordinate plane.

Programming and Web Development Bootcamps (F - 07)

Class Description:

This course is ideal for those who have a passion for programming and are just beginning their journey! The main objective of the course is to help students acquire a better understanding of programming and web development concepts while also having fun. The course starts with the basics—the Python (20 hours) programming language, learning the Java programming language (20 hours), and website development (40 hours). Students will focus on learning HTML (Hyper-Text Markup Language), CSS (Cascading Style Sheets), and JS (Javascript). If you aspire to create something awesome and amazing, no matter where you are in your coding journey, then this course is the right fit for you. Even if you already have a basic, self-taught knowledge of programming, this course will give you a solid foundation and a better understanding of the intricacies, reasons, and explanations for why certain things are the way they are. Moreover, you will get a good grasp of the Linux command line as well. No previous programming experience is required. Enthusiasm is the only prerequisite!
